



## Music, interpretation of senses and musical taste

#### **ABSTRACT**

We are increasingly immersed in a technological and globalized world. Each season, new media emerge and new ways of feeling the world are transformed. In this way, music has always been and always will be a propelling machine for the dissemination of languages, obtaining more and more affective memory for the various tastes. Thus, the main objective of the research was to map music and interpretation of meanings in auditorium programs The Voice (Brazil and around the world), regarding the vocal and instrumental display of young talents. For the methodology, the YouTube channel was emphatically used during the capture, selection and analysis of songs around the world – until the year 2025. Google searches, books, pdf texts were also a reason to settle more readings. Initially we showed the importance of sounds/noises/music and; Subsequently, talented young people were present in the analyses. It was concluded, then, that the 10 (ten) selected songs brought varied elements from the sound of the juvenile voice on stage, to the sound of musical instruments, the reception of the judges, family, friends, audience (inside and outside the auditoriums). Including, thus, my way of hearing/feeling/interpreting.

#### 1 INTRODUCTION

We are increasingly immersed in a technological and globalized world. Each season, new media emerge and new ways of feeling the world are transformed. In this way, music has always been and always will be a propelling machine for the dissemination of languages, obtaining more and more affective memory for the various tastes.

Whether by hearing at a distance, in some media; or by its sonority and visual reception, something together; music arising from the dissemination of various sounds and/or noises, it manifests itself and transforms meanings. Given this, the objective continues through the mapping of songs and interpretation of meanings in global auditorium programs *The Voice* (Brazil and around the world), regarding the vocal and instrumental display of young talents. Initially, the text deals with the analytical importance of some sounds/noises/music and, subsequently, talented young people are present for the analysis.

The justification for this subject is the passion that music cradles my senses Duarte (2020; 2021; 2022) and (DUARTE; OMENA; HORA, in press), and for a lifetime, through hearing and sight. And more, in the relationship of consequent senses: touch, smell, taste. "The interpretation of the senses in music is a complex combination of physiological, emotional, social and cultural factors, which make each person have a unique experience when listening to music" (GOOGLE, 2025).

So, many challenges along the way? What musical tastes will these be? Therefore, as a possibility of answers, we name voices, noise, instrumental sounds that impact the musical field, directly or indirectly, beyond affective memory and, that in contemporaneity and/or future generations, new experiments continue to occur.

### 2 GOAL

Map songs and interpretation of meanings in auditorium programs *The Voice* (Brazil and around the world), regarding the vocal and instrumental display of young talents.

#### 3 METHODOLOGY

For the methodology, the YouTube channel was emphatically used during the capture, selection and analysis of songs around the world – until the year 2025. Google searches, books, pdf texts were also a reason to settle other readings.

## 4 MUSIC, INTERPRETATION OF SENSES AND MUSICAL TASTE

#### 4.1 FIRST ACT

From the dissemination and multiplication of sounds, noises and music, we take into account that:

Music, in its history, is a long conversation between *sound* (as a periodic recurrence, production of constancy) and *noise* (as a relative disturbance of stability, superposition of complex, irrational, outdated pulses). Sound and noise are not absolutely opposed in nature: it is a *continuum*, a gradual passage that cultures will manage, defining within each one the margin of separation between the two categories (contemporary music is perhaps the one in which the threshold of this distinction has become more fragile and undecidable (WISNIK, 2017, p. 32).



Hermeto Pascoal (Alagoas/Brazil) - "Beard Soil, Kettle, etc".<sup>2</sup> Video time of 00:05:49. He, considered Hermeto solo, musician and multi-instrumentalist. In this example, it is worth highlighting the various sounds, noises generated from your own body. At the microphone, his voice humming in unconventional things, such as: white strands of his beard (imitating stringed instruments); Kettle filled with water and another pot also full; *pet* bottle with water; bird, clay handicraft (blowing a lot on it, imitating birds); bicycle bomb in which Hermeto ends his sound by blowing a carnival marchinha and lullaby. Another example of Hermeto's sonority, at the *Live at Montreux Jazz* Festival *in* 1979, his voice at the microphone demystifying the sound, emitting various noises. His hands touching the keyboard, metaphorically, "Breaking Everything".<sup>3</sup> Video time 00:05:40. He is accompanied by: a guitarist, a drummer, a trumpeter, a keyboardist, and more, accompaniment to the triangle, etc.

Tom Zé (Bahia/Brazil). Tom Zé in his arrangements and orchestrations is known for using blenders, radios, typewriters, waxers, recorders, keyboards, bottles, etc. From conventional instruments to a complex sound system built by him, he joins the erudite to the popular, from the contemporary to the traditional. "Toc"<sup>4</sup>, video tempo of 00:04:55, Tom Zé has the participation of other music professionals for sound transformation, such as: Daniel Maia (guitar, vocals), Jarbas Mariz (cavaquinho, 12-string viola, percussion), Cristina Carneiro (keyboards), Felipe Alves (bass) and Fábio Alves (vocals and percussion). And, himself, Tom Zé – triangle and special instruments. And so "toc" arises, special attention to the toc on each musical instrument and, in particular, extracts of the wind and the voice of a partner in the band, simulating playing the drums with the drumsticks. It is not to play for a general audience, but for an audience that immerses itself in the function that each musical instrument can sensitize the hearing. And so is Tom Zé's orchestration.

And when Azzamchik brings the song "América Dubai"? In the video there is the inscription of the paused lyrics of the song in the Uzbekistan language (his mother tongue), his singing voice and finger cracks make a wide difference to our senses. In the background,

a mixed voice accompanies various moments of the song<sup>5</sup>. And, at times, Azzamchik imitates some accompanying musical instruments. Video time of 00:03:43. How would it be possible to meet Azzamchik, who speaks Uzbek and Russian (too), if it weren't for the long reach of the media and our interest in new musical arrangements? I believe, then, in the purification of musical taste when we allow ourselves to know something new that touches the senses.

Bukhchuluun Ganburged (Bukh) (Mongolia/Asia) brings to us: "Mum and dad".<sup>6</sup> Bukh, considered an Australian Mongolian throat singer and Morin Khuur player<sup>7</sup>, in a time of 00:07:33 demonstrates to the 4 judges of *The Voice* Australia and the audience, ways of transmitting feelings through music. "Mum and dad", whose lyrics translated, here into Portuguese, are below:

Lyric translation (English):
May your journey be happy, my father wishes.
when I return from distant lands, my parents will welcome me with joy.
Take care of your honor in a foreign land, my mother teaches.
When I return from distant lands, my parents will welcome me with joy.

Bukh's music has a melancholic tone, even more so when his voice imitates nature, the sound of birds and is reminiscent of the mountainous region of his people, in Mongolia. The judges of "The Voice Australia" are delighted, turn their chairs and shower him with questions. The sound it emits from its mouth is something surreal. His wife cries, moved. Bukh's little daughter goes on stage, within reach of her arms.

And finally, the drumsticks are played, and Késsi<sup>8</sup> begins "Africa" by Ismaël Lô (as the host of the program The *Voice Afrique Francophone says*, next to Késsi's relative, next to the stage). Her typical performance of African voices is as if she "tears" her voice. It is a song of praise for peace for your African mainland land. The judges appreciate the voice of young Késsi. The musical instruments do not appear in the video, however, we hear at least the

drumming of the drumsticks, percussion, a kind of mandolin, drums, guitar, etc. There are 4 jurors. The audience was extremely attentive to the sound. Numerous applauses at the end. Video time of 00:01:33. Késsi ends the song by thanking in French: *merci*.

### 2.2 SECOND ACT

The main elements of music are melody, harmony, and rhythm, which work together to create a composition. Melody is the sequence of notes, harmony is the combination of several sounds played at the same time, and rhythm is the movement of sounds, organized by duration and time [...] And, other important elements: timbre: It is the unique quality of a sound, which allows you to differentiate one instrument from another or one voice from another. Pitch: Refers to the property of the sound being lower or higher. The position of the notes on a musical staff indicates their pitch (GOOGLE, 2025).

Music and sound borrow from various voices<sup>9</sup>. Sound and/or visual reception; vocals/vocals; musical instruments, family and friends, judges, the audience (present and distant) in auditorium shows is something of long reach. Something that media platforms predispose to multiply at different times. In general, a huge audience follows the shows. All attentive to each vocal, to each instrument played, to each *performance*, to each emotion felt, attention to technique, which cause ecstasy and, several times, "food" for the affective memory. Be memories for the songs previously known. Let the former, touchingly, be new to the ears. And so, music travels through the senses, regardless of language.

It is noticeable the guidance that the musical performers of *The Voice* have from their teachers, family members, as well as their efforts with the songs and musicians chosen to sing. It's something so perfect that the judges invariably get emotional. At times they sing along and/or after the end of the *performance*. There are times when young people cry, judges cry, the audience cries and the family cries too. There are many details during the interpretation, and it is impossible to (un)cover all of them.

Although the children mentioned here have in adults (technicians, parents and listening to musicians who wrote the chosen songs) it is inevitable to realize how talented they are, how artistic they are. There is an immense emotional and physical effort to meet the general expectation of the public; and specifically, jurors. So, below are some notes perceived in the performance of the 10 talents: all with their respective microphones in hand:
